



Anales del Sistema Sanitario de Navarra (ISSNp: 1137-6627, ISSNe: 2340-3527), created in 1997, is a scientific journal that publishes, double-blind peer-reviewed, research articles, review articles, clinical notes, and letters to the Editor, in Spanish or English, on the field of health/disease, including public health, health management, medical specialties, primary health care and nursing.

The aim of the journal is to provide health professionals with a channel to communicate and disseminate research results.

The journal publishes three numbers by year (April, August and December), and all its contents are open access (distributed under a <u>CC BY-SA</u> license), free of charges for readers and authors; the copyright belongs to the publishing organization: <u>Health Department</u> of the Government of Navarra.

Anales del Sistema Sanitario de Navarra is indexed in PubMed and in Science citation Index Expanded (JCR). In 2023, the journal obtained the Editorial Quality Seal, with mention of Good Editorial Practices in Gender Equality, awarded by the Spanish Foundation of Science and Technology (FECYT). From April 2022 the journal is published in only-electronic format. All its content is available in RECYT, SciELO and, since 2022, in Pubmed Central. The acceptance rate of manuscripts is under 20%.
